WHEREAS, Jim Detterline being assigned to the Longs Peak area in 1986, becoming Supervisor at Longs in 1987; and

WHEREAS, Jim Detterline, completing over 162 summit climbs of Longs Peak, and participating in over 600 rescues in his Park Service career; and

WHEREAS, Jim Detterline has maintained the utmost in professional standards serving the National Park Service, the community of Estes Park and all of its citizens, giving knowledgeable advice and timely help whenever asked.
