WHEREAS, Estes Park community leaders and citizens can use "America Recycles Day" as an opportunity to spread the word about recycling opportunities including the Town's local recycling center co-located with the waste transfer station, residential and commercial recycling service available to Estes Valley residents and local businesses through private enterprise, and innovative nonprofit recycling programs such as Freecycle and Terracycle; and

WHEREAS, by encouraging businesses, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, schools and individuals to recognize America Recycles Day 2012, we can further promote recycling as an environmentally efficient and economically smart habit; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Estes Park, proclaim Thursday, November 15, 2012, as
