# Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, paint and similar products are no longer acceptable in landfill nor are they eligible for single stream recycling, and

**WHEREAS**, these petroleum based products can be recycled into road base and similar products, saving natural resources for other uses, and

**WHEREAS**, in the Estes Valley, there was no viable way to recycle paint products, without carrying the hazardous liquid 50 miles or more, until Bestway Painting offered an alternative, and

**WHEREAS**, Bestway picks up the paint, stores it safely, reuses what they can, and recycles the remaining product through the Paint Care program and other resources, and

**WHEREAS**, Bestway has now removed 100 tons of paint related product from the Estes Valley, and


**WHEREAS**, we wish to celebrate the stupendous job Bestway Painting is doing by removing paint products from the Estes Valley, and


