WHEREAS, Colorado is a premiere bicycling state, recognizing the month of June as Colorado Bike Month with many events around the state; and

WHEREAS, in November 2014, the Town of Estes Park was recognized with an Honorable Mention by the League of American Bicyclists for its efforts to improve the well-being of the community through bike and pedestrian friendliness; and

WHEREAS, the National Household Travel Survey showed that the number of trips made by bicycles in the U.S. more than doubled from 1.7 billion in 2001, to 4 billion in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the education of bicyclists and motorists as to the proper and safe operation of bicycles is important to ensure the safety and comfort of all users; and

WHEREAS, bicycle commuting benefits both employees and employers through better employee health and fitness; reduced commuting and parking costs; and

WHEREAS, the Estes Park Board of Trustees encourages everyone to consider participating in Bike to Work, Bike to Play Week activities June 17-30, including Bike to Work Day June 24, to learn more about bicycle safety, and to consider bicycling more often.




